Service Agreement for Non-Potable Water:

1. Non-potable irrigation water provided under this agreement is transported through a system owned, maintained, and operated by Orchard Irrigation Company (OIC). Customer therefore acknowledges that Acton Municipal Utility District (AMUD) does not guarantee, nor assume responsibility for, the quality and dependability of service provided by said system.
2. **Customer acknowledges that irrigation water delivered through said system originates from Lake Granbury and/or the Brazos River, and that this water may contain concentrations of soluble salts, minerals, chemicals, impurities, sediments, or organisms. CUSTOMER THEREFORE HEREBY ASSUMES ALL RISK, AND HEREBY FOREVER RELEASES AND HOLDS AMUD AND OIC HARMLESS FOR ANY DAMAGE OR INJURY TO FLOWERS, SHRUBS, PLANTS, TREES, OR TURFGRASSES, AS WELL AS FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH AS A RESULT OF CONTACT WITH OR INGESTION OF SUCH NON-POTABLE WATER BY ANY HUMAN BEING OR ANIMAL.**
3. AMUD agrees to provide water to Customer, and Customer agrees to purchase such service from AMUD in accordance with all AMUD rules, regulations, rates and charges as existing or as amended from time to time. Customer acknowledges that the cost of said water may vary from time to time. Customer further acknowledges that the drilling of water wells within AMUD boundaries is prohibited.
4. All water meters installed by AMUD are for the sole use of Customer, who shall not transfer service from one property or owner to another, nor share, sell or sub-meter service to any other person, dwelling, business or entity, under penalty of law.
5. AMUD and OIC shall have the right to locate service facilities on the property of Customer at a point chosen by AMUD and OIC, and Customer hereby grants to AMUD and OIC an easement and reasonable access for installation, maintenance, repair and removal of AMUD and OIC equipment, facilities, and appurtenances.
6. Customer shall install, at his, her or its own expense, a service line from the AMUD meter or tap to the point of use, shall install a cut-off valve on the Customer side of meter, and hereby releases and holds AMUD and OIC harmless from all claims for damage to real or personal property resulting therefrom or caused thereby.
7. AMUD and OIC shall not be responsible for the repair or replacement of any real or personal property within any utility easement or right-of-way damaged in the process of installation, repair, maintenance, or removal of any AMUD or OIC facility or equipment.
8. **Customer acknowledges that the irrigation system connected to this alternate water supply shall NOT be connected to AMUD's potable water system. Customer hereby consents to inspection(s) by AMUD to insure that the irrigation system is disconnected from the potable water supply.**
9. **All construction shall be in accordance with the current general development policy and construction standards of AMUD. AMUD shall inspect all water facilities on Customer's side of the meter prior to providing service. The inspection is to prevent cross-connection between potable (safe) water system and any non-potable (unsafe) water system. A cut-off valve must be included in the customer service line between the meter and any irrigation system. Ditches in which water service lines are laid cannot be closed until inspected by AMUD personnel. Arrangements for coordination of these inspections must be made by the builder, owner, or an authorized representative, with at least 24 hours notice to AMUD.**
